#### **Additional Ways to Practice WOW Words**

- Look/Say/Cover/Write/Check: Look at your word. Say your word. Cover your word. Try to write your word from memory. Check to see if you spelled it right. Do this 2 times for each of your words.
- Make flashcards of your words
- Write your words using one color for vowels and another color for consonants
- Write your words in ABC order
- Write your words 3 times each
- Rainbow Write: Write your words in pencil. Trace over each word 3 times with different colors.

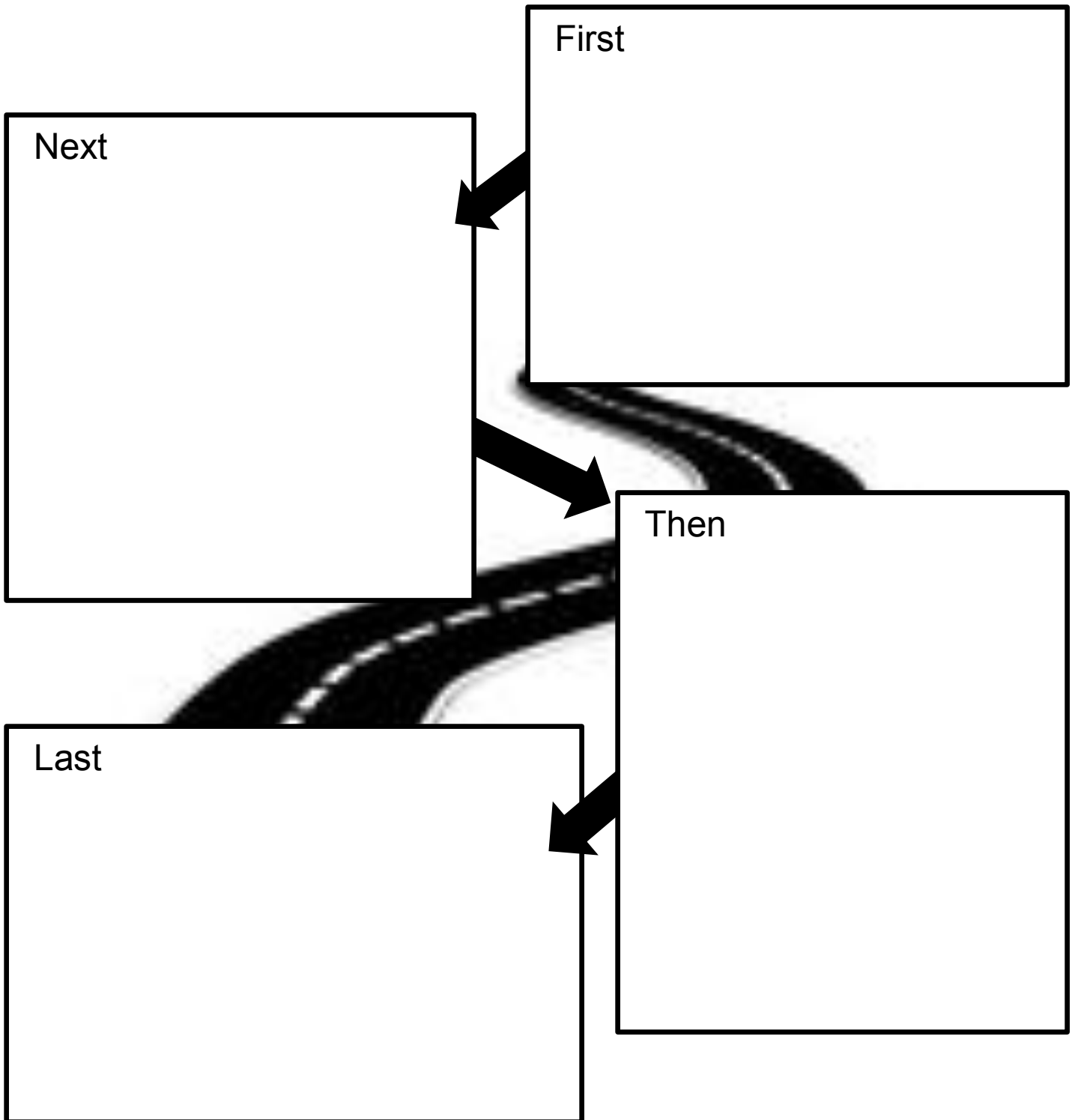

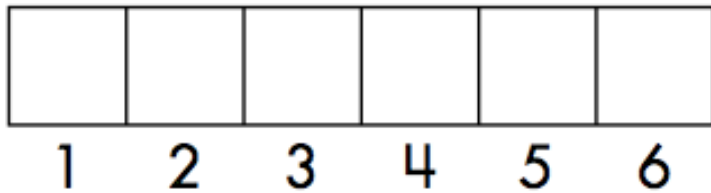
