

## First Grade Digraphs and Blends

These are digraphs and consonant blends that we will cover in first grade.

### Definitions:

- Digraph: a pair of consonants that make one sound that is not associated with either consonant individually
- Consonant Blend: a group of consonants that appear together with now vowel between them, each sound is pronounced

### Digraphs

**sh:** shoe, shed, ship, shot, shell, shovel, shadow, shelf, shave, shirt

**ch:** chair, cherry, chimney, chop, check, cheese, chick, chain, chin

**th:** thumb, thorn, thimble, three, thermometer, think, then, that

**wh:** wheel, whiskers, wheelbarrow, whistle, whale, when, why, where

### Blends

**st:** star, stem, stop, stump, stamp, stick, sting, stir, stool, stun

**sp:** spider, spool, spoon, spear, spill, sponge, spun, spot

**sk:** skate, ski, skull, skirt, skeleton, skip, skunk, skateboard, skill

**sm:** smile, smell, smoke, smug, smack

**sc:** scooter, school, scout, scarecrow, scarf, scale

**sn:** snail, snake, snap, snowman, snow, snail, snap, snip, snug

**sw:** swing, swan, switch, sweater, swing, swim, swig

**pl:** plus, plug, plum, plant, pliers, plate, plane, plop, plot, plan

**cr:** crab, crown, crayon, crib, cry, crack, crackers, crop

**cl:** cloud, clip, clown, clock, clap, climb, clam, clap, clip, clot

**fr:** frog, fry, fruit, frame, freckle, freezer, frill, fret

**fl:** flag, flower, float, fly, flashlight, flip, flop, flap

**bl:** block, blanket, blade, blouse, bread, blindfold

**br:** broom, bride, bridge, brush, brat, brag

**gr:** grapes, grass, groceries, grill, grasshopper, grip

**gl:** glasses, globe, glass, glad, glow, glitter

**pr:** present, price, pray, prize, pretzel, pray

**tr:** tree, trap, track, tractor, triangle, truck, trip, trap, trot

**dr:** drum, drill, dress, drip, dream, dragon, drive, drag

**tw:** twin, twelve, twenty, twig

**qu:** quilt, quack, quarter, queen, question, quiet, quit
