5. 33 strawberries were on the table. I ate 12 strawberries. How many strawberries are on the table now?



**11.** Julie has 13 more strawberries than Lucy. Julie has 21 strawberries. How many strawberries does Lucy have?

**12.** Lucy has 12 strawberries. Julie has 15 strawberries. How many fewer strawberries does Lucy have than Julie?

**13.** Lucy has 8 fewer strawberries than Julie. Lucy has 17 strawberries. How many strawberries does Julie have?

**14.** Lucy has 12 fewer strawberries than Julie. Julie has 21 strawberries. How many strawberries does Lucy have?
